WHEREAS, the Board of Directors of the Adirondack Council wishes to congratulate The Lake Colby Association on its diligent work in securing passage of Chapter 425 of the Laws of 2007; and

WHEREAS, The Lake Colby Association is a New York membership corporation representing residential, commercial, and governmental interests on Lake Colby in the Town of Harrietstown, Franklin County, New York; and

WHEREAS, The Lake Colby Association has worked vigorously to carry out its mission of preserving Lake Colby for the quiet enjoyment of shore owners, public users, and future generations; and

WHEREAS, The Lake Colby Association took action to prevent the disruption of Lake Colby by seeking to limit the use of watercraft to those with motors under 10 horsepower (Hp) on said lake and supporting legislation which amended the navigation law to prohibit the operation of larger motor boats on said lake in the town of Harrietstown in the county of Franklin; and

WHEREAS, The Lake Colby Association continues to ensure the preservation of Lake Colby for homeowners, hospital patients, business owners, recreationists and wildlife through education and advocacy; and
